CATBEE

amigurumi crochet pattern

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Skill level: Intermediate

Measurements: 4-inches tall

Abbreviations

Ch: chain

Sc: single crochet

Dc: double crochet

Inc: increase

Inv dec: invisible decrease

Ss: slip stitch

*This pattern is written in US crochet terms.

Materials

2.5mm hook

3mm hook

Dk-weight cotton yarn in white, black and pink.

Black crochet thread

Craft glue

Darning needle

Polyester fiberfill



A sweet little cat, in the body of a bee.

Or perhaps, a sweet little bee who is just as curious as a cat.

Meet CatBee, an original 100% special creation by Aisha Sa'ad.

Head

With two strands of dk-weight white yarn and a 3mm hook:

Round 1: Sc 6 in magic ring {6}.

Round 2: [Inc] around {12}.

Ears

With two strands of dk-weight white yarn and a 3mm hook, make 2:

Round 1: Sc 3 in magic ring {3}.

Round 2: [Inc] around {6}.

Round 3: [Inc, sc 1] around {9}.

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

Flatten piece.

Eyes

Make 2 with white yarn + 2.5mm hook:

Round 1: Sc 6 in magic ring {6}.

Round 2: Inc around {12}.

Clean fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

Cheeks

Make 2 with pale pink yarn + 2.5mm hook:

Round 1: Sc 6 in magic ring {6}.

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

Legs

Make 2 with white yarn + 2.5mm hook:

Round 1: Sc 5 in magic ring {5}.

Rounds 2-3: Sc around {5}.

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

* No stuffing required for the legs.

Round 3: [Inc, sc 1] around {18}.

Round 4: [Inc, sc 2] around $\{24\}$.

Round 5: [Inc, sc 3] around {30}.

Round 6: [Inc, sc 4] around {36}.

Round 7: [Inc, sc 5] around {42}.

Rounds 8-10 (3 rounds altogether): Sc around {42}.

Round II: [Inv dec, sc 5] around {36}.

Round 12: [Inv dec, sc 4] around $\{30\}$.

Round 13: [Inv dec, sc 3] around {24}.

Round 14: [Inv dec, sc 2] around {18}.

Stuff head firmly. Press piece to flatten the front slightly.

Round 15: [Inv dec, sc 1] around {12}.

Round 16: [Inv dec] around {6}.

Fasten off and weave in ends.



Body

With black yarn + 2.5mm hook:

Round 1: Sc 6 in magic ring {6}.

Round 2: [Inc] around {12}.

Change to white yarn.

Round 3: [Inc, sc 1] around {18}.

Change to black yarn.

Round 4: Sc around {18}.

Change to white yarn.

Round 5: Sc around {18}.

Change to black yarn.

Round 6: Sc around {18}.

Change to white yarn.

Round 7: Sc around {18}.

Change to black yarn.

Round 8: Sc around {18}.

Change to white yarn.

Round 9: Sc around {18}.

Change to black yarn.

Round 10: Sc around {18}.

Change to white yarn.

Round 11: Sc around {18}.

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

Stuff firmly.

Designing the face

Eyes

- 1. With your darning needle and black crochet thread, make a horizontal backstitch (2 sts long) across the centre of each eye piece. Leave the thread a little loose for a curvier look. Knot ends at the back.
- 2. Attach the eyes below Round 7 of the head, with approximately 3 sts in between each eye.

Mouth

- 1. With a darning needle and black crochet thread, make a horizontal backstitch (4 sts long) below the eyes, centred between them.
- 2. Bring the thread back up the first point, and now make a curved line all the way across to the second point of the mouth you made earlier. This time, leave the thread in a loose curve.
- 3. Apply craft glue to secure shape in place. Trim off excess yarn.

Wings Part 1

With white yarn + 2.5mm hook:

Round I: Sc 6 in magic ring {5}.

Round 2: [Inc] around {10}.

Rounds 3-4: Sc around {10}.

Fasten off and leave a long end.

Wings Part 2

With white yarn + 2.5mm hook:

Round 1: Sc 6 in magic ring {5}.

Round 2: [Inc] around {10}.

Rounds 3-4: Sc around {10}.

Now you will be joining onto the first wing you made from Wings Part 1.

Round 5: Ss onto the next wing, sc 9, then continue onto the second wing — sc 10 {20}.

Assembly (in order)

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- 1. Sew on eyes.
- 2. Sew on mouth.
- 3. Sew on cheeks.
- 4. Sew on ears (Round 4-7 of the head).
- 5. Sew body onto the head.
- 6. Sew on arms.
- 7. Sew on wings separately, to the sides of the body at the back.
- 8. Sew on legs.

Round 6: Sc 5, inv dec, sc 9, inv dec, sc 2 {18}.

Round 7: [Inv dec, sc 1] around {12}.

Fasten off and leave a long end for sewing.

Flatten piece.

You may use the tail end from Wings Part 1 to close up any gaps between the two wing pieces (by making some backstitches).

* No stuffing is required for the wings.

** Repeat the instructions for Wings Part 1 and 2 to make another set of wings.
